Seeds & Plants

## Let's Plant a snack & measure!



### Supplies:

- 3 Biodegradable Planting Pots & Bag of Potting Soil
- Small cups with 3 types of seeds: (G) Cat Grass; (R) Radish; & (P) Sugar Snap Peas
- Measuring tape & 3 popsicle sticks for each pot

### Instructions:

- Label your popsicle sticks: **G** (grass), **R** (radish), & **P** (peas)
- Fill each pot with soil about 3/4 full from the top.
- Stick one popsicle stick/plant label in each pot.
- Sprinkle seeds that match the label into the soil of that pot.
- Add more soil on top of seeds & tap down lightly. Leave a bit of space from top of pot to allow for water.
- Place 3 pots in a sunny location and water every 1-2 days.
- When the seedlings have grown 2 - 4 inches, transplant them to a larger pot or ground in a sunny location. You can plant these pots with the seedlings directly into soil or a larger pot.



### Observations:

- Check your pots daily to see what seed sprouts first, and which one sprouts last.
- Measure the plants as they grow. Which get the tallest?
- As they grow, how do the leaves look the same and different?
- Once harvested, how do you describe the taste and texture of the Sugar Snap peas and radishes?
